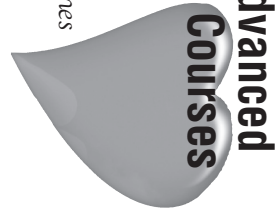

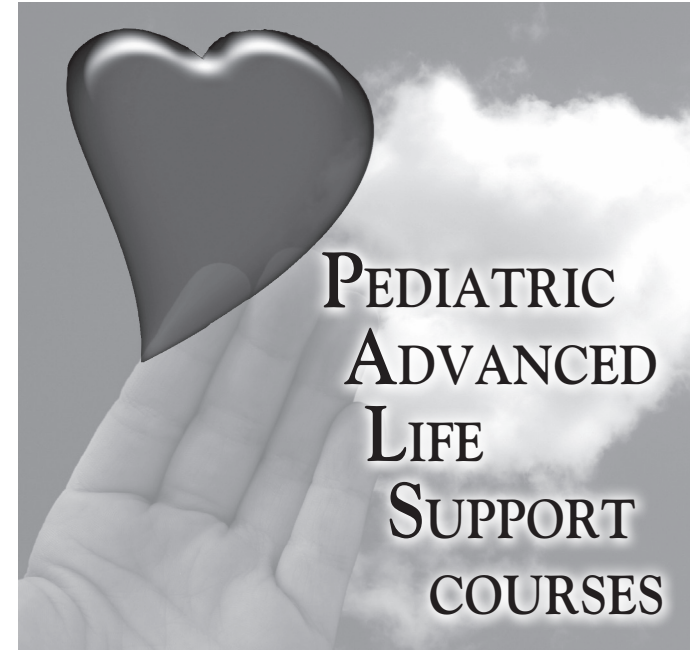

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

1 PALS Initial Provider Course (2-day course)

Course designed to provide the healthcare professional with knowledge and skills necessary for successful resuscitative efforts. The course provides information through a series of case-based, clinical scenarios. **In addition to skill-based evaluations, participants must have a current BLS healthcare provider card.**

2 PALS Renewal Course (1-day course)

Course designed for the healthcare professional who needs to renew their PALS status **prior** to their current expiration date. The renewal course provides a review of information through a series of case-based, clinical scenarios. **In addition to skill-based evaluations, participants must have a current PALS provider card, as well as a current BLS healthcare provider card.**

COURSE GOALS

The goals of the Pediatric Advanced Life Support Course are to provide the student with:

- Information needed for recognizing the infant or child at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest
- Information and strategies for preventing cardiopulmonary arrest in infants and children
- The cognitive and psychomotor skills necessary for resuscitating and stabilizing shock or cardiopulmonary arrest
