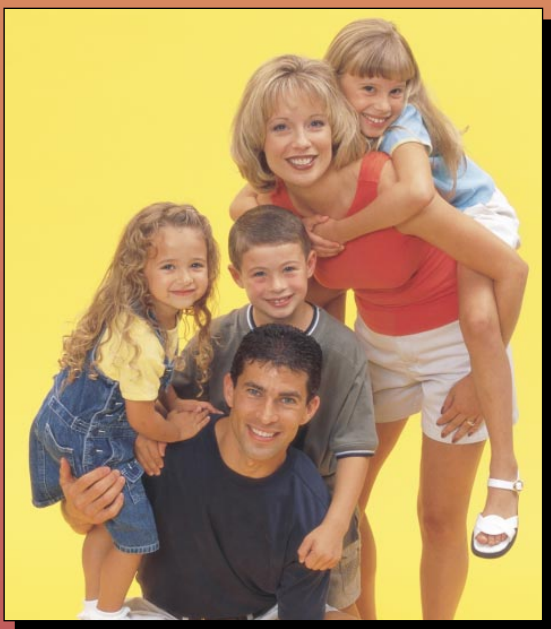

# Registry Employment for RN's

**Loyola University Health System (LUHS)**, located minutes west of Chicago's Loop, is a nationally recognized leader in providing specialty and primary health care services to its patients. ## You may qualify to join our dynamic team...

LUHS requires Registry Nurses to be State of Illinois licensed RN's with a minimum of one year of critical care or general nursing experience in an acute care setting within the last three years. A passing score on the EKG exam is required for Telemetry, a passing score on the Critical Care Exam is required for Critical Care and a passing score on the Pediatric Critical Care Exam is required for Pediatrics.



## Our orientation and reporting structure...

After completing a 2-day education and support service orientation and a clinical orientation of not more than two days, Registry Nurses are assigned to units within their approved area:

- **Medical/Surgical**
- **Critical Care**
- **Maternity/Child**

Registry Nurses report to the Supplemental Staffing Coordinator, who is responsible for scheduling and ongoing evaluation.
